# \Columns alignment

## Abstract

This file provides example of setting the alignment of \Columns on the page: right (default), left or center.

The column are `0.44\textwidth`, and we use `\columnspan`.

We also provide one last example, showing how we can manipulate space between columns, by re-defining `\beforecolumnseparator` and `\aftercolumnseparator`.

### 1 Right (default)

Left side left side left side left side left side  
left side left side left side left side left side

Right side right side right side right side  
right side right side right side right side right  
side right side

### 2 Left

Left side left side left side left side left side  
left side left side left side left side left side

Right side right side right side right side  
right side right side right side right side right  
side right side

### 3 Center

Left side left side left side left side left side  
left side left side left side left side left side

Right side right side right side right side  
right side right side right side right side right  
side right side

### 4 Center, setting space between columns

Now, we set the spaces between columns, to have all the line occupied.
