

Abstract

This file provides an example of typesetting verse for a dramatic text with `reledmac` and `thalie` packages.

We use the `thalie` features to manage characters.

We use the following features of `reledmac` to typeset the verses:

- `\antilabe` to show correctly the second half of a split line of verse (`antilabe`);
- `\afterantilabe` to add more space after `\antilabe`;
- `\setcounter{stanzaindentsrepetition}` and `\setcounter{startstanzaindentsrepetition}` to have the first line of a reply/stanza indented, but not the following ones;
- `\skipnumbering` to avoid counting the first half of an `antilabe` in the line counting.
